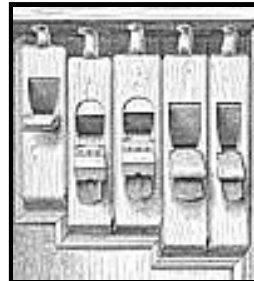

Word and figurative marks

This directory is taken from the book 'Die Deutsche Werkzeugindustrie' [[DWI](#)] (1942). I have transferred it here because there is currently no easy way to find the name of a manufacturer's trademark. This overview is ideal because the figurative marks are described with words (often in several ways) and can thus be found with a text search (directly in the browser or via a search engine).

The names of the companies for which there is further information on my homepage or which have their own homepage are designed as links. Many of the company pages contain information about the respective company history. Trademarks can often be found there and it can be seen whether there have been takeovers of other companies or name changes.

I have also linked to sites that give historical information about the company in question. Here you can often see when a company existed and whether company buildings have been preserved.
